Problem	What to do
Hearing aid not functioning	 Clean speaker opening/earpiece Press lower part of multi-function button for 3 seconds (chapter 9) Charge hearing aid (chapter 4)
Hearing aid whistles	 Insert hearing aid correctly (chapter 6) Contact your ENT/GP or hearing care professional
Hearing aid too loud	Decrease volume if volume control available (chapter 8)
Hearing aid not loud enough or distorted	 Increase volume if volume control available (chapter 8) Charge hearing aid (chapter 4) Clean speaker opening/earpiece Contact your hearing care professional
Hearing aid plays two beeps	Charge hearing aid (chapter 4)
Hearing aid will not switch on	Charge hearing aid (chapter 4) Perform step 2 of the rebooting process (chapter 15)
Indicator light on hearing aid does not light up when hearing aid placed in charging inserts	 Insert hearing aid correctly into charger (chapter 4) Connect charger to external power supply (chapter 3) Wait three hours after placing hearing aid in charger, regardless of LED behavior

Quick start: getting started

1. Charging your hearing aids



Place your hearing aid in the charger case

2. Defining the hearing aid for the left/right ear (blue indicator for left, red indicator for right)



Indicator on the back of the hearing aid



Indicator on the speaker

3. Putting on the hearing aid:



Place the hearing aid behind your ear



Insert the earpiece into your ear canal



If there is an anchor attached to the earpiece, tuck it into the bowl of your ear to secure your hearing aid

4. Operating the hearing aid:



Multifunction button

- 1. On/off switch
- 2. Volume control and/or a
- 3. Program change



Touch control: tap to

- 1. Accept/end phone call
- 2. Pause/resume streaming
- 3. Start/stop voice assistant

Enjoy easy connectivity to all Bluetooth® enabled phones for hands-free phone calls, streaming music, e-books, etc.

Step 1: Initial pairing



- A. On your device (e.g., a phone), ensure that Bluetooth wireless technology is enabled and search for Bluetooth enabled devices in the connectivity setting menu.
- B. Switch on both hearing aids. You now have 3 minutes to pair your hearing aids with your device.



The hearing aids can be connected to iPhone® and Android™ smartphones.

After your hearing aids have been paired to your device, they will automatically connect again when switched on.



Step 2: How to operate hands-free phone calls

Making a call: Enter the phone number and press the dial button. You will hear the dial tone through your hearing aids. Your hearing aids pick up your voice through the microphones.



Accepting a call: Tapping the top of your ear twice or a short press on the upper or lower part of the multifunction button on the hearing aid (less than 2 seconds) or directly on your phone.

Ending & rejecting a call: Tapping the top of your ear twice or a long press on the upper or lower part of the multifunction button on the hearing aid (more than 2 seconds) or directly on your phone.
